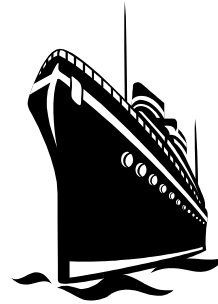

This organization is an affiliate of the International Association for Food Protection. In Milwaukee, Wisconsin, October 1911, 35 men from Australia, Canada and the US, interested in improving the quality of milk, organized the International Association of Dairy and Milk Inspectors. By 1936, the Association became the International Association of Milk Sanitarians. In 1947, its name changed to the International Association of Milk and Food Sanitarians, Inc. Again in 1966, the Association changed to the International Association of Milk, Food and Environmental Sanitarians. In October 1999, Members voted to accept the current name, International Association for Food Protection. The mission of IAFP is "To provide food safety professionals worldwide with a forum to exchange information on protecting the food supply." We are aligned with that goal.

### What is SCAFP?

**SCAFP** is a group of food professionals interested in learning and seeing more about food safety methods, technologies and research. It was founded in 2002 and is a non-profit organization. All donations are tax deductible.

First and foremost, we get together and discuss items of interest that relate to food safety.
